



Two manufacturing exhibitions to kick off in Hanoi

HANOI – Two international **manufacturing** exhibitions, **Vietnam Manufacturing Expo 2009** and **NEPCON Vietnam 2009**, will take place in the capital city of Hanoi on May 28-30.

Vietnam Manufacturing Expo 2009 is the only **manufacturing** event in Hanoi in the first half of **2009** with over 1,000 products (450 brands) from 20 countries and territories. The exhibition comprises four shows, InterPlas **Vietnam 2009**, Intermold **Vietnam 2009**, Automotivi **Vietnam 2009**, and Automation **Vietnam 2009**, and features advanced technologies in four key **manufacturing** sectors, plastics and rubber, mold and die, auto parts, and automation and assembly.

Most of the technologies are designed to raise the efficiency of Vietnamese **manufacturing** in terms of operations, cost, marketing and creative processes.

NEPCON Vietnam 2009 will run simultaneously as an international platform for 250 enterprises from 20 countries and territories to demonstrate technologies in the electronics **manufacturing** industry and help Vietnamese enterprises develop support industries.

"The exhibitions will be a high-tech playground to push up business in this difficult period," said Nichapa Yoswee, managing director of Reed Tradex as the organizer.

The exhibitions will be held at the Hanoi International Center for Exhibition and are expected to draw around 10,000 enterprises.
